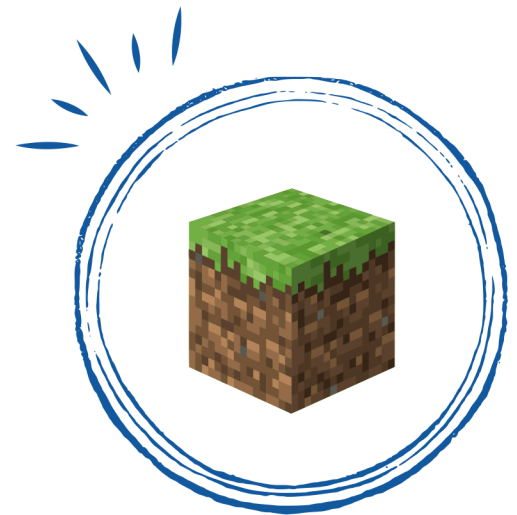


### How do I talk to my child/student?
